We use dramatherapy techniques to support individuals to express themselves, communicate, develop self-confidence and self-esteem, and the skills they need to maximise their independence and achieve their goals in life. We do this by focusing on what individuals can do and would like to be able to do in the future, and we use symbols, pictures, photographs and whatever works best to help them to communicate, make sense of the world and their routines.

Our services

Drama, music, singing and dance

We create, perform and film our own theatre shows to help others to understand issues faced by people with disabilities and autism. Our Danspiration crew also lead inclusive dance workshops at local community venues.

Inclusive sports and healthy lifestyles

We offer opportunities to get involved in accessible exercise, inclusive sports, menu planning and meal preparation, and learning more about the benefits of healthy living.

Work experience and volunteering

Community and education

This is all about getting out and about and becoming more independent. It includes travel training, money management and accessing retail and leisure facilities. We also offer the opportunity to gain qualifications in the creative arts and lots of other subjects.
